Report on External Communications

Summary of Activities

The Working Group's regular Monday morning meetings have been adjourned for the time being due to Councillors work commitments but at a minimum the Mayor and Aby have continued to catch up on a Monday morning to discuss priorities in terms of external communications for the week ahead.

1) Announcement of New Councillor

An announcement about our new Councillor, John Bradley was posted on the ATC website and Facebook page. It was also shared to the relevant Arundel Facebook pages and groups.

2) Ford Road Development Public Consultation

The Ford Road Development Public Consultation was publicised on the ATC website and Facebook page.

3) Social Distancing Signage

Roundel stickers from ADC were placed along the pavement down Mill Road around the car park and to Swanbourne Lake. Sadly these have since been removed but we don't know why. Some of the corrugated plastic social distancing sings had also been damaged or removed so these have been replaced where necessary.
