## Arundel Town Council Platinum Jubilee Gardening Competition

### Terms and conditions of entry

By entering into Arundel Town Council's Platinum Jubilee Gardening Competition, all participants are agreeing to adhere to the following terms and conditions:

1. The 'entrant' is the resident, organisation or business entering the competition.
2. The 'competition coordinator' is Arundel Town Council, hereby known as ATC.
1. The 'garden' is any of the following, visible to the general public without entering upon private land:
  - a. Residential entries: hanging basket, window box or other container and front garden.
  - b. Business premises entry: a display.
  - c. Community entries: community garden.
2. All entries must be within the boundary lines of the parish of Arundel. If you are unsure on whether the property falls within the boundary lines, please contact Arundel Town Council or visit [www.arundeltowncouncil.gov.uk/parish-boundaries/](http://www.arundeltowncouncil.gov.uk/parish-boundaries/).
3. Entry is free
4. Only entrants registered before the published closing date will be entered into the judging process. No late entries will be considered, and responsibility cannot be taken for entries not received.
5. Judging will take place after the closing date of 15<sup>th</sup> August. Judges will not enter private property. Judge's decisions are final.
6. On the day of judging, photos will be taken of the entry. Entrants agree to these being used by ATC on social media platforms, ATC's website, press publications and as part of the Platinum Jubilee Year Exhibition at the Town Hall at the end of the year.
7. Gardens will be assessed and marked following the judging criteria. Awards will then be given to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and highly commended for each category.



8. Prizes are as stated, non-transferable and with no cash alternatives.
9. Winners will be announced at The Gardens Association Flower and Produce Show on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> August, with prizes presented then. Venue and timings will be confirmed prior to the day.
10. If winners are unable to attend the presentation, confirmation letters will be sent to them following the show. Every effort will be made to contact the winner using contact details provided. Should the winner be unreachable, ATC reserve the right to offer the prize to the runner up of that category as confirmed by the judging panel.
11. Confirmation of prize winners will be made in writing and on the ATC website and social media platforms.
12. ATC reserve the right to hold identifiable data about entrants and share within the council and specified parties to effectively carry out responsibilities. Data will not be shared with third parties unless legally required to do so.
