REVERSING THE CAUSES OF CLIMATE CHANGE:

COMPETITION

Arundel Town Council's Environment Working Group is sponsoring a competition to find the best ideas for tackling the causes of climate change that can be implemented in and around Arundel. Whilst we do not believe that Arundel can save the world, we do believe that individual, organisation and community has a role to play.

The Rules

1. The competition is open to everyone who lives, works or goes to school in Arundel.
2. People may enter as individually, or as part of an organisation or group.
3. In the case of an entry by an organisation or a group (e.g. an Arundel club or society) it is accepted that some members may come from outside of the town. This will not debar the group from entering provided the organisation or club is based in Arundel.
4. The competition is open to three age groups:
 - (a) under 11 years old (or attending primary school)
 - (b) 11-18 years old
 - (c) over 18

In category (a) and (b) support or assistance from a person over the top age (e.g. a school teacher) is permitted provided that most of the project is carried out by people falling within the category.

5. Entrants are asked to identify or devise a practical and affordable way to contribute to tackling the causes of climate change and enhancing sustainability in and around Arundel. The winning entrants in both age groups will win an amount of up to £200 to implement their idea. In the event that the idea will cost less than £200 to implement, the remaining moneys may be used to support other deserving schemes at the Judge's discretion. If the scheme costs more than £200 to implement the Town Council will support the entrant in applying for funding from other sources.
6. Entrants are asked to make a poster (up to A3 in size) explaining their idea and use the form provided on the Town Council website to submit their entry, with any supporting written documents if available. The closing date for entries is Sunday 19th February 2023. Results will be announced on Saturday 18 March 2023 and will be on display at a Reversing Climate Change exhibition in the Town Hall on 18 & 19 March 2023.
7. The Judges will be The Mayor, the Town Clerk, and the Council Environment Working Group.
