

Arundel Tidal Walls Scheme – 27 November - 8 December 2023

Arundel Tidal Walls Scheme Construction Work

During the past week, the grout stock was placed to protect any water from flowing behind the piles. The final 3 piles were backdriven on Friday 25 November.

Over the week commencing 27 November, work will begin to install backfill behind the sheet piles. It is anticipated that the first round of backfilling will be completed during the week commencing 4 December. The jack up barge will be moving along the river during high tide on 28 November and 4 December. These movements will require movement during non daylight hours and will require the use of floodlights.

It has been agreed with the Environmental Health Officer from Arun District Council to extend working hours during the week commencing 27 November to utilise optimal tide levels. Work is anticipated to finish by 2000hrs.



Updates and Closures: River Road, Tarrant Wharf, Memorial Gardens, Arun River and Mill Road

During the week commencing 27 November 2023 there will temporary road closures in place along River Road as the sheet pile and equipment for piling is transported to the river. The project team will continue to improve the information provided information to residents regarding access and when deliveries will take place.

Memorial Gardens is closed whilst works continues until April 2024. Construction continues along Arun River which will require the use of floodlights on the barge.
